⁶ The multitude of camels shall cover thee, the dromedaries of Mid'-i-an and E'-phah; all they from She'-ba shall come: they shall bring gold and incense; and they shall shew forth the praises of the LORD.

⁷ All the flocks of Ke'-dar shall be gathered together unto thee, the rams of Nebai'-oth shall minister unto thee: they shall come up with acceptance on mine altar, and I will glorify the house of my glory.

⁸ Who *are* these *that fly* as a cloud, and as the doves to their windows?

⁹ Surely the isles shall wait for me, and the ships of Tar'-shish first, to bring thy sons from far, their silver and their gold with them, unto the name of the LORD thy God, and to the Holy One of Is'-ra-el, because he hath glorified thee.

¹⁰ And the sons of strangers shall build up thy walls, and their kings shall minister unto thee: for in my wrath I smote thee, but in my favour have I had mercy on thee.

¹¹ Therefore thy gates shall be open continually; they shall not be shut day nor night; that *men* may bring unto thee the forces of the Gen'-tiles, and *that* their kings *may be* brought.

¹² For the nation and kingdom that will not serve thee shall perish; yea, *those* nations shall be utterly wasted.

¹⁷ For brass I will bring gold, and for iron I will bring silver, and for wood brass, and for stones iron: I will also make thy officers peace, and thine exactors righteousness.

¹⁸ Violence shall no more be heard in thy land, wasting nor destruction within thy borders; but thou shalt call thy walls Salvation, and thy gates Praise.

I made the widow's heart sing.

¹⁴I put on righteousness as my clothing;
just was my robe and my turban.

¹⁵I was eyes to the blind
and feet to the lame.

¹⁶I was a father to the needy;

I took up the case of the stranger.

¹⁷I broke the fangs of the wicked
and snatched the victims from their teeth.

¹⁸I thought, 'I will die in my own house,
my days as numerous as the grains of sand.

¹⁹My roots will reach to the water,
and the dew will lie all night on my branches.

²⁰My glory will remain fresh in me,
the bow ever new in my hand.'

²¹Men listened to me expectantly,
waiting in silence for my counsel.

²²After I had spoken, they spoke no more;
my words fell gently on their ears.

²³They waited for me as for showers
